

Are Zooper Strollers Car Seat Compatible?

The 2011 Zooper Bolero, Tango, Waltz, Twist, models are infant car seat compatible. Each of these strollers comes with an included security strap that secures the car seat to the stroller. The strollers were designed to be as universally compatible as possible with all infant seats but some just simply won't fit in the stroller seat. We have tested a few and here is a list of models that

we've found to be compatible:

- Graco SnugRide
- Graco SafeSeat
- Britax Companion
- Britax Chaperone
- Evenflo On My Way
- Peg Perego Primo Viaggio
- Chicco Keyfit 30

Or if the car seat base width is 12"/30.48cm or less.

Does an infant car seat need to snap onto the stroller?

Depending on the brand & model of your infant car seats, the car seat may or may not lock onto the stroller front bar. The only way to securely attach the infant car seat to any Zooper stroller is by using the included Infant car seat straps and making sure they are tightened as much as possible. You can test the car seat installation by moving it in all directions to ensure a tight fit to the carrier. It is also necessary that the infant is secured using the infant car seat's own restraint system.

Can I add a toddler seat or toddler trailer on my Zooper stroller?

No, Zooper strollers are not designed to use with a toddler seat, toddler trailer or similar attach, which may result in the stroller becoming unstable and unsafe.

Are the seat covers of Zooper Strollers washable?

Yes, Zooper seat covers may be removed from the stroller and washed in the gentle cycle. We recommend using a gentle detergent and flat or line drying.

The canopy can only be spot washed.
