


2 Gently pull up the inner glass shade to remove it.

Align the top slot with the top inner threaded hole.
Insert the long #8-32 screw through the slot and tighten it to the top inner threaded hole.

LONG #8-32 SCREW


 Insert a long #8-32 screw (provided) through the hole underneath the socket bracket and tighten it to the mounting plate bottom inner threaded hole.


#### Install the Lamp

**CAUTION:** To reduce the risk of a burn or electric shock during relamping, disconnect the power to the fixture by turning the wall switch off.

<b>NOTE:</b> The G9 lamp has an integral glass envelope and is thus safe to be used without a lamp shield.
Use <b>MAX</b> 120 Volt, <b>60</b> Watt Type T4, G9 Base, Bi-Pin Halogen Lamp.
1 Handle the new replacement lamp with a soft cloth to prevent the natural oils on the fingertips from collecting on the lamp. This will help extend the life of the lamp.
2 Push the lamp pins completely into the socket holes.

3 Align and push the inner glass shade completely onto the plastic post on the mounting plate and secure by sliding completely down.

 A new halogen lamp may smoke slightly when it is used for the first time. This is perfectly normal; the protective coating is simply being vaporized.

### Two Tips For Prolonging Halogen Lamp Life

- First avoid touching the lamp with bare hands during installation. Any contaminant, even the oil from your hands can deteriorate the lamp. Rubbing alcohol can be used to remove any contaminant.
- Second, do not run the lamps at full power when you do not need to. However, if dimming the fixture for an extended period of time, occasionally bring the light up to full brightness for a few minutes to complete the halogen cycle.
