### Features

Imagine a floor that seems to meld two entirely different materials—soft, sensual fabric and strong, solid wood. This gorgeous hardwood has a delicately sanded surface that actually feels soft to the touch.

- Each unique plank is hand-brushed with firm wire implements, which dig into the soft portions of the wood, leaving the harder minerals intact. The result is a new emphasis on the grain and the six color variations—the grain stands out dynamically, and the colors are enriched.
- Can be installed virtually anywhere—on, above, or below grade in a nail, staple, glue-down, or floating installation method.

In addition, Shaw buys from suppliers who practice managed forestry techniques.


