

Before assembly:

- Please read all instructions before beginning assembly.
- Please note this could be dangerous if incorrectly installed.
- Unpack and assemble this furniture, on a protective surface, in the room it will be used.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.

Cross head screwdriver (long reach)
Pencil / Ruler / Spirit level / Masking tape / Hammer
Dril fitted with a Ø 8mm drill bit (as required for the wall type)

Care Instructions


- Clean surface with a slightly damp cloth and wipe dry using a soft cloth.

- Periodically check and tighten all fixings.














- Attach fixed shelf (E) to the middle panel (L) with wooden dowel (b), then insert cam lock (d) into the holes as pictured on the underside of panels and tighten.
- Attach bottom panel (B) to the middle panel (L) with wooden dowel (b), then insert socket head screw (o) using socket head key (p).




- Attach top panel (A), bottom panel (B) and fixed shelf (E) to the left / right side panel (C&D) with wooden dowel (b), then insert cam lock (d) into the holes as pictured on the underside of panels and tighten.
- Attach front plinth / back plinth (G&H) to the bottom panel (B) and the left / right side panel (C&D) with wooden dowel (b). Fit the feet (a) to front plinth / back plinth (G&H).




 Turn the carcass on the front. Put the back panel (F) between top and bottom panel and draw a line according to fixed shelf.



• Before fixing the back panel (F), the diagonal lines must be equal. ("a" to "a" and "b" to "b")





 Position nails (n) 5 mm in from side edge of the back panel with distance 100 mm between each other. Fix them using the hammer.















• Insert the shelf support (i) into the holes of left / right side panel at the desired height, then place the shelf (I) onto the support.



















• Fit the upper and lower sliding fitting (q&r) to door panel (J) with screw (f). Do not tighten both fittings fully!


- Start with left door.
- Fit lower sliding fitting (q) into the groove in the bottom panel (B), cover the upper part of the door as pictured, then insert upper sliding fitting (r) into the groove in the top panel (A) and tighten.



- Follow the pictures to adjust the level of the door. Once doors adjusted, secure with screws (f).
- Repeat the steps 12 and 13 for right door.









• CAREFUL! Insert the wooden dowel (b)into the back side of the right door (J).
