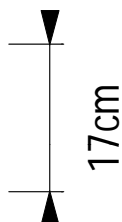
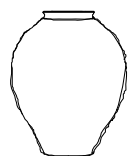
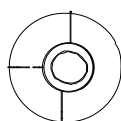
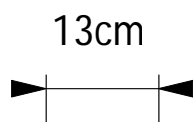
Unglazed Porcelain exterior

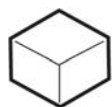

***Cleaning Instructions***

Apply a little diluted washing-up liquid with a wet sponge, submerge in clean water and rinse. Allow to drip dry. For tougher stains Moooi recommends using a washing brush with gentle bristles. Rub with a little diluted washing-up liquid until the stain disappears.
