
Like the Chinese ceramist we also leave our makers marks in the pot (like partinglines, shrink), and thereby make a part of the vase's history visible.

Cleaning Instructions

Apply a little diluted washing-up liquid with a wet sponge, submerge in clean water ands rinse. Allow to drip dry. For tougher stains Moooi recommends using a washing brush with gentle bristles. Rub with a little diluted washing-up liquid until the stain disappears.
