Ball Stud Removal. Note: Ball stud removal may not be necessary for camera attachment.
Loosen tension screw (B) several turns. Rotate socket (C) as pictured. Push down on ball stud (D) and remove by passing through hole in socket (C).

Attach ball stud (**D**) to threaded fitting in bottom of camera. Reinsert ball stud (**D**) into socket (**C**). Rotate and angle camera to desired position. Tighten tension screw (**B**) securely.
