
Before you call please:

- Review the contents of your shipment to determine what you are missing. This unit is shipped in 3 cartons. Make sure you have received all cartons.






Make sure you have all cartons.








STEP 1 Estimated Time: 10 minutes





STEP 2 Estimated Time: 15 minutes

Attach T spacers to outer gables with drawer slide screws.



STEP 3 Estimated Time: 10 minutes






STEP 4 Estimated Time: 5 minutes

Insert JRN nuts into the holes on each end of the inner gables.

The holes are drilled through. You can insert them from either side.




STEP 5 Estimated Time: 5 minutes Identifying the upper and lower stabilizers Insert JRN nuts into the holes on each end of the upper (B3) and lower (B4) stabilizers. **Upper Stabilizers** Top edge (FINISHED) is rounded **Upper Stabilizers** Side hole is close to the **UNFINISHED** edge Side hole is close to the finished edge **Lower Stabilizers** Lower Stabilizers

STEP 6 Estimated Time: 10 minutes

Attach "T" spacers and drawer glides to Inner Gables

Attach "T" spacers to ONE side of each inner gable with drawer slide screws



Attach drawer glides to "T" spacers on inner gables.

Position the drawer glides with:


- A) The wheel at the finished edge
- B) The wheel on the bottom

IMPORTANT:


Before attaching the drawer glides, determine the TOP and BOTTOM of each inner gable.

- A. Measure from each edge of the "T" Spacer to each unfinished edge.
- B. The measurement that is approximately 4" will be the **BOTTOM**.

Check the position of the drawer glides carefully before you attach them to the inner gables.




Repeat steps 6a & 6b for the 2nd side of the inner gables.





STEP 7 Estimated Time: 5 minutes

Using JCB connectors, and the Allen Key provided, attach each lower stabilizer (B4), one at a time, to both inner gables




If you have any difficulty tightening the JCB connector, use a screwdriver to adjust the JRN nut to make sure the hole is facing the opening for the connector






STEP 8 Estimated Time: 5 minutes

Using JCB connectors, attach each upper stabilizer (B3), one at a time, to both inner gables.



STEP 9 Estimated Time: 10 minutes

Attach one outer gable to stabilizers with JCB connectors




STEP 10 Estimated Time: 5 minutes

Slide

10a Spread the wooden slats out across the inner stabilizers


10b Slide the slats into the wide spaces of the metal U-channel (B6) on one outer gable.




STEP 11 Estimated Time: 10 minutes


Attach second outer gable to stabilizers with JCB connectors

- **11a** Secure the gable in place with connectors, but don't fully tighten
- **11b** Ensure the slats are set inside the u-channel and that they haven't pulled out of the first outer gable.
- 11c Firmly tighten the connectors







STEP 12 Estimated Time: 5 minutes PER DRAWER




12b Screw black twister dowels into drawer fronts





12c Attach drawer sides to drawer back with 1½" Hi Lo screws







12e Turn drawer upside down and slide drawer bottom into grooves








Left Drawer Side



STEP 13 Estimated Time: 2 minutes

Insert drawers



Note: When drawers are installed correctly, you will not be able to remove them without first lifting up the drawer front.

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Furniture Care Q&A

- Q. How do I clean your products?
- **A.** We recommend that you simply wipe your products with a clean, damp cloth and then dry immediately with another clean cloth to maximize the life span and look of your unit
- Q. Can I paint or varnish your products?
- **A.** Our products are made from durable composite woods with a laminate finish and therefore should not be painted or varnished.
- Q. Are they waterproof?
- A. NO. If liquid is spilled and quickly wiped up, no damage will be done to your product. However, continuous exposure to liquids or high humidity may cause damage to the board.
